Our Community has many school and childcare options that appeal to varying student needs and family priorities. Babysitting & Daycare Options:

- Options including affordable in-home babysitting groups and licensed Jewish daycares
- And. . . who said childcare has to be so expensive? Subsidized Child Care Program (CCIS) which heavily subsidizes costs of childcare for eligible families plus many scholarships ensure that childcare is very affordable.

Preschool options:

- Many preschool options which offer scholarships based on the state's Educational Improvement Tax Credit Program
- Excellent financial assistance availability, ensuring that our schools remain extremely affordable for families within our community

Elementary School options to fit every child's needs!

- Kohelet Yeshiva Lab School: A modern orthodox yeshiva day school. Serves Kindergarten, 1st, 2nd, and 6th grades with coeducational classrooms. This school opened in 2014 and adds a grade every year to its elementary and middle school programs.



ABOUT OUR RABBI



Since August 2015, our shul has been led by Rabbi Yehoshua Yeamans, who inspires us with his deep knowledge of Torah, enthusiasm for learning and growth, and genuine love for Klal Yisrael and Eretz Yisrael. Rabbi Yeamans grew up in Scarsdale, New York. After two years of learning in Yeshivat Kerem B'Yavneh in Eretz Yisrael, Rabbi Yeamans spent eight years learning

in Yeshivas Ner Yisrael, where he received Semicha in both Orach Chaim and Yoreh Deah.

In addition to his rabbinical degrees and training, Rabbi Yeamans earned his Masters in Business
Administration from Loyola University in Baltimore, Maryland. Prior to his appointment at our shul,
Rabbi Yeamans served as the Assistant Rabbi of Beth Israel Synagogue in Edmonton, Alberta. He has spent
over a decade actively engaging youth of all ages as a NCSY director and camp director, and ensures that our
shul is a place where all children feel welcomed and engaged. Rabbi Yeamans' strong leadership skills, personable
nature, and diverse life experiences allow him to connect with Jews from all walks of life. Rabbi Yeamans is married to
Sarah Wachs, a native of Philadelphia. She has specific training in the laws of Taharas Hamishpacha and offers engaging
shiurim to the women in our community. The Yeamans embrace opportunities to open their hearts and home to all members of
our community, and as the parents of young children, they take special pleasure in welcoming other young families and couples to
Philadelphia.

- Politz Hebrew Academy: An affiliate of Torah Umesorah and the Consortium of Jewish Day Schools. Serves Kindergarten - 8th grade with separate buildings and instruction for boys and girls starting in 1st grade.
- Politz of Cherry Hill: A modern orthodox day school. Serves Preschool - 8th grade with separate gender classes from 3rd grade and up.
- Torah Academy of Greater Philadelphia: An Affiliate of Torah U'Mesorah and the Consortium of Jewish Day Schools. Serves Preschool - 8th grade with separate gender classes from 4th grade up.

High School options to fit every child's needs!

- Kohelet Yeshiva High School: A modern orthodox yeshiva high school for boys and girls with separate gender for the majority of classes.
- Kosloff Torah Academy for Girls: An affiliate of Torah Umesorah. An all-girls high school.
- The Mesivta: An affiliate of Torah Umesorah. An all-boys yeshiva high school.
- Foxman Torah Institute of Cherry Hill: An affiliate of Yeshiva Chofetz Chaim in Queens, NY. An all-boys yeshiva high school.
- The Talmudical Yeshiva of Philadelphia: A mesivta and bais medrash for boys.
- Yesodai Hatorah: Yeshiva high school for boys. A satellite of Mesivta Yesodei Yeshurun in Queens, New York.

Special Education

- Orot program provides customized programs encompassing academic, behavioral, and social curricula aimed at educating the "whole" child.
- State of Pennsylvania provides generous special education services at no charge to qualifying students.
- State of Pennsylvania offers a no-cost health insurance plan for children with special needs, regardless of family income or assets.

AFFORDABLE SCHOOL TUITION

And... with all these school options... we also have affordable tuition!

- Philadelphia Jewish Day Schools are beneficiaries of the State of Pennsylvania's Education Improvement Tax Credit Program.
- Tax Credit program translates into heavy state-sponsored scholarships for eligible children attending private schools.
- Most families in our community benefit from very reduced school tuitions, due to the very generous eligibility requirements for this program. For example, a family of four with an income of \$135,000 can still be eligible for very large state sponsored scholarships.
- All our wonderful schools ensure that each family can afford Torah education for their children.
