Kiddush & Shalosh Seudos

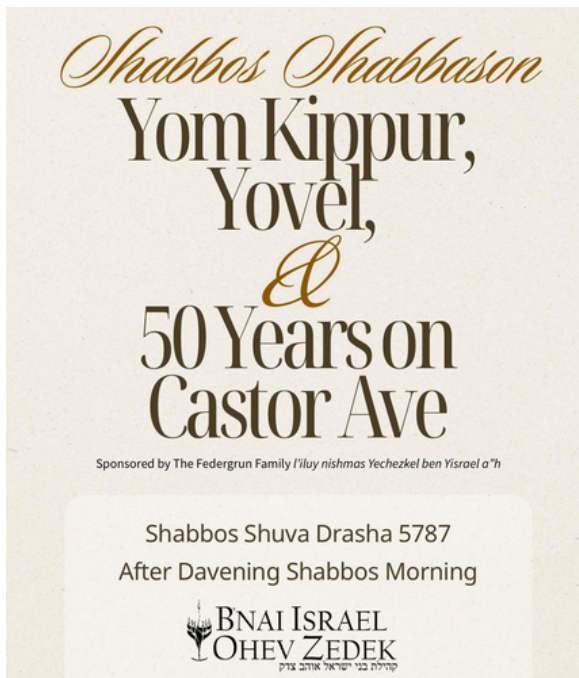
Kiddush is sponsored by Haviv and Sandy David in memory of Sandy's father, Klonomos ben Yehoshua.
